

Bed exit alert:

An ingenious, cost-effective solution

Inpatient falls are common place and remain a challenge for the NHS. Often, a fall increases the financial burden on the Trust through increased length of stay and there is the potential for additional care costs on discharge. And, even a fall that does not cause physical injury can cause anxiety and distress for the patient and their family.



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To help make staff aware of a patient exiting their bed within the shortest possible time 'Bed Exit Alert' can be added to a Static Systems' nurse call solution within a matter of minutes.



At a glance:

- Designed for easy connection to pressure floor mats placed alongside the patient's bed.
- Provides a practical alternative to constant supervision of patients with cognitive impairment or who cannot easily walk unsupported.
- Can address concerns raised as part of a patient risk assessment, particularly when used in single bed rooms.
- Works as an integral part of a Static Systems' nurse call system with automatic prioritising of events and 'follow-the-light' operation to assist staff in quickly locating the call.
- The same interface unit can be used to provide additional functionality, including:
 - Remote nurse call buttons
 - Chair press pads
 - Enuresis alarm
 - Special needs call units
 - Bedroom door alarm
 - Infusion pump alert
- Enhanced features:
 - User specified call types
 - Automatic lighting switch-on
 - Clinical reporting and analytics
